

Instructions on how to determine the parcel the stormwater account was set up for

The account number indicates the parcel map number. For example, if your account number is 4103333700, then the parcel map number would be S41-033-337-00. One way to access the parcel information is to go to the Somerset County Website at <https://www.co.somerset.pa.us/pages/realestatedisclaimer.asp> , **click to continue** to the real estate search.
